Growing Citrus Indoors

- 8-12 hours of bright light
- Best choices: Lemon, Limes, Oranges.
- Use a light, airy soil mix.
- Heavy feeders. Use a citrus fertilizer and follow directions for potted plants.
- Citrus likes humidity- spray foliage occasionally.
- Try to keep summer temperatures around 75-90 degrees. Winter temperatures 60-70 degrees.
- Citrus can go outside on your patio for the summer months. Transition to a full sun spot slowly. When bringing back indoors for the fall, transition the plant indoors when the outside and inside temperatures are the same.
- Water deep and infrequently.
- Rotate occasionally to allow sun on all sides.
